#### **Audition Information**

- Registration: We encourage all dancers to register and pay your audition fee (\$25) in advance via Ballet
  Chelsea's Online portal Dance Studio Pro. If you would prefer to pay via cash or check, you can do so on the
  day of the audition, but we ask that you email <a href="mailto:info@balletchelsea.org">info@balletchelsea.org</a> and let us know you are coming.
- Audition Registration Form: Dancers may submit their forms to <a href="mailto:info@balletchelsea.org">info@balletchelsea.org</a> or bring in with you to the audition. We will also have forms available at the studio should you need to fill one out on the day of the audition.
  - o Note: If you are auditioning for the Profession Training Program (PTP), you will need to submit a personal statement, answering all the questions at the bottom of the Audition Registration Form.
- Dancers should arrive 30 min 1 hr before their scheduled audition to check in and warm-up.
- The audition will consist of ballet center work but may also include contemporary or classical choreographic
  phrases that focus on movement quality. Dancers are encouraged to warm-up prior to their audition; studio
  space will be available.
- Female dancers should wear a simple, solid color leotard, pink or flesh colored tights, and pink or flesh colored technique and pointe shoes if the dancer is en pointe.
- Men should wear a white shirt, black tights and white or black shoes.

- 4:45-6:00 pm Auditions continue for Professional Training Program (ages 14+) & Professional Company Artists (ages 18+)
