Creative Ballet Tiny Tappers Beginning Ballet 1	<p>Girls: Pink leotard, pink or flesh toned tights, pink or flesh toned ballet shoes, hair secured back from face (ponytail, braid, bun).</p> <p>Boys: White form-fitting shirt, black tights or leggings, and black ballet shoes.</p>
Beginning Ballet 2 Beginning Ballet 3 Ballet 1	<p>Girls: Black leotard, pink or flesh toned tights, pink or flesh toned ballet slippers, hair in a bun. Skirted leotards are not allowed.</p> <p>Boys: White form-fitting shirt, black tights or leggings, and black ballet shoes.</p>
Ballet 2 - 8	<p>Girls / Women: Black or solid color leotard, pink or flesh toned tights, pink or flesh toned technique shoes and pointe shoes. Hair in a bun or French twist, cleanly off the face & neck. Dress code variations may be allowed at the instructor's discretion.</p> <p>Boys / Men: White form-fitting shirt, black tights or leggings, and black ballet shoes.</p>
Jazz	Tank or leotard, jazz pants or dance shorts, jazz shoes (tan colored without laces), hair secured off the face in a ponytail.
Hip Hop, Bop Hop	Tight fitting clothing, hair secured off the face in a ponytail. Clean athletic shoes, worn only in the studio.
Contemporary	<p>Women: Tank top or leotard with dance shorts, bare feet, and hair secured off the face in a ponytail.</p> <p>Men: Shorts or tight fitting joggers, t-shirts, and bare feet.</p>
Mini Movers	Comfortable clothes, ballet shoes, jazz shoes, cotton socks (synthetic blends are generally slippery on the floor) or bare feet
Adult Classes	Comfortable workout clothes. Ballet shoes are required for ballet classes.
